Airports and Flights

Cracow has one city airport – Krakow-Balice (KRK) which is served by a number of budget and standard airlines. To check your flight options please visit:

Fast train connects the airport with the Krakow Główny station in the city centre. The journey lasts 16 minutes and the ticket is 6 PLN one way. Please check the airport's website for train schedule. The train station is located 200m from the airport and is served by a free shuttle bus departing from outside the main airport building.

Another option is the Katowice–Pyrzowice (KTW) airport, also served with a number of budget airlines. Katowice airport is located 80 km north – west from Cracow, the journey to the city centre takes 90 minutes by bus and costs 88 PLN (20 euro) for return ticket.

The Venue

ISTA Feis takes place in Nowohuckie Centrum Kultury (Nowa Huta Culture Centre) in Cracow. You can get there by tram, bus or you can take a taxi.

From the city centre take tram no 4 or 15 to Plac Centralny stop (ca. 20 minutes), then walk across the park to the venue.

Cracow offers a huge choice of hotels or hostels located in the Main Square area or nearby, allowing visitors to combine their feis activities with sightseeing and shopping.
